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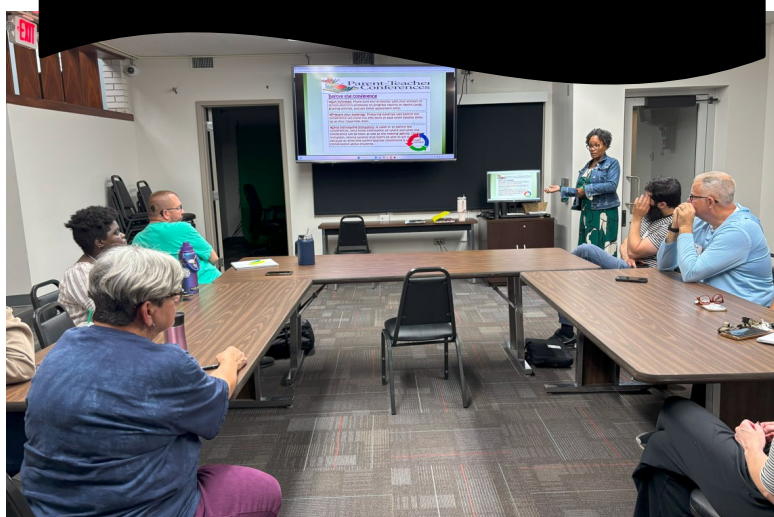
## Madison's Volleyball Club

## New Teacher Training

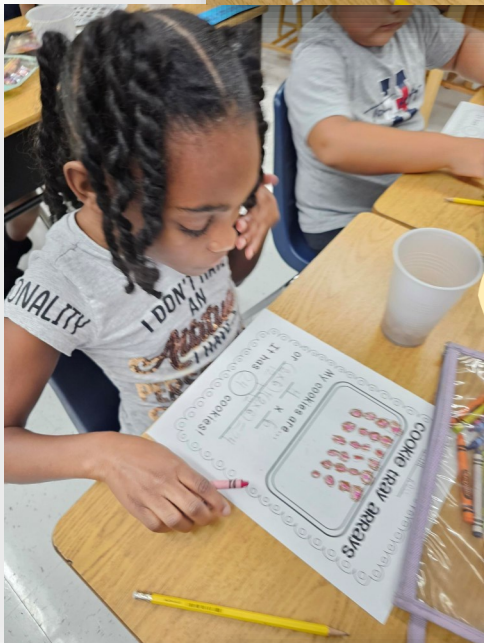
During Institute day, the library managers attended a workshop designed for them.



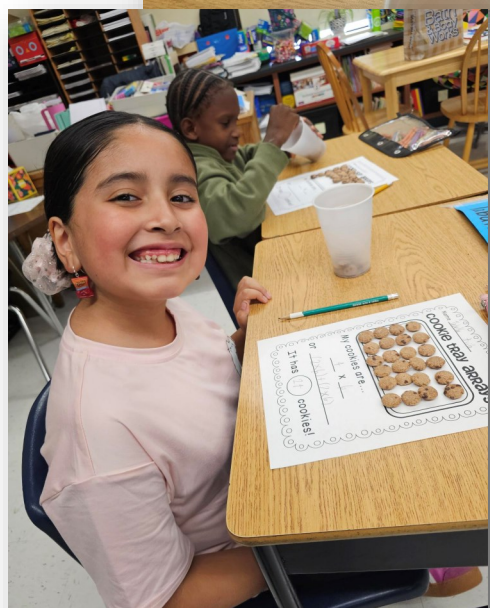
Dr. Hartzol, Director of Special Education, facilitated the new teacher training workshop.
